

General Terms Applicable to All Licenses

1. Ownership

The Licensee does not acquire ownership of any nasheeds, recordings, compositions, artwork, metadata, or other intellectual property.

All copyrights and intellectual property rights remain with the original Artists and/or No Copyright Nasheeds (NCN), as applicable.

Purchasing a license grants the Licensee a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to use the licensed content in accordance with these Terms.

2. Permitted Use

Subject to the purchased license, the Licensee may use the licensed nasheeds in personal or commercial projects including, but not limited to:

- YouTube videos
- Social media content
- Podcasts
- Online courses
- Presentations
- Client projects
- Websites
- Mobile applications (where permitted by the purchased license)
- SaaS platforms (where permitted by the purchased license)
- Commercial advertising
- Other approved creative works

Nasheeds must always form part of a larger creative work and may not be distributed as standalone audio files.

3. Commercial Monetization

Unless otherwise stated by the purchased license, the Licensee may monetize projects containing licensed nasheeds through advertising, sponsorships, subscriptions, memberships, or commercial sales.

Purchasing a license does not transfer copyright ownership.

4. Prohibited Use

The Licensee may not:

- Sell, resell, sublicense, rent, lease or redistribute the nasheeds as standalone files.
- Upload the nasheeds to competing music libraries, streaming platforms, marketplaces or download websites.
- Claim ownership, authorship or copyright.
- Register the nasheeds with Content ID or similar copyright claiming systems.
- Use the nasheeds for unlawful, defamatory, hateful or misleading content.
- Remove copyright information or metadata where applicable.
- Share purchased files with third parties who are not covered by the purchased license.

5. Attribution

Attribution is appreciated but not required unless specifically stated within an Enterprise Agreement.

Where attribution is required, NCN and/or the original Artist shall be credited in a reasonable manner.

6. License Types

NCN currently offers the following licenses:

- License for Forever
- Mujahideen Lifetime License
- Mujahideen Monthly License
- Enterprise License

Each license grants different usage rights.

The Licensee is responsible for purchasing the license appropriate for their intended use.

7. Enterprise License

Enterprise Licenses are intended for businesses requiring advanced commercial integration.

Examples include:

- Mobile applications
- SaaS platforms
- Enterprise software
- Digital products
- Streaming services
- Educational platforms
- Custom commercial solutions

Enterprise Licenses are issued through a separate written agreement.

Enterprise pricing is determined individually based on project scope and licensing requirements.

8. Enterprise Streaming

Where permitted under an Enterprise Agreement:

- Licensed tracks may be streamed inside approved applications.
- Streaming may occur through NCN's streaming infrastructure, private cloud storage, API integration, or another approved delivery method.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing:

- Users may stream licensed music.
- Users may not download the original MP3 files.
- Users may not export audio.
- Users may not redistribute the audio.
- Users may not extract standalone music files.

Temporary caching necessary for playback is permitted provided it does not enable permanent storage or public distribution of the licensed audio.

9. API Integration

Where applicable, NCN may provide secure API access or other approved integration methods.

API credentials remain the property of NCN.

API access may be suspended or revoked if the Licensee violates these Terms or the Enterprise Agreement.

10. Catalog Access

Enterprise customers may receive access to one or more approved NCN catalogs, including:

- NCN Production
- Copyright Free

Catalog availability may change over time.

NCN reserves the right to add, remove or update tracks.

11. License Duration

License duration depends on the purchased license.

Lifetime licenses remain valid indefinitely for projects created during the active license period.

Monthly licenses remain valid only while the subscription remains active.

Enterprise licenses are typically issued on an annual basis unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Projects lawfully created and distributed during the active license period remain licensed after expiration where permitted by the applicable license.

12. Existing Works After License Expiry

Unless otherwise specified by the purchased license, projects, videos, applications, websites, or other creative works lawfully created and distributed during an active license period may remain available and continue to be accessed after the license expires.

After expiration, no new works may be created using the licensed content until the applicable license has been renewed.

13. Confidentiality

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, any commercial terms, pricing, or confidential business information exchanged between NCN and the Licensee shall remain confidential except where disclosure is required by law.

14. Private Hosting

Enterprise customers may privately host licensed audio files within secure infrastructure solely for delivering the licensed service, provided reasonable measures are implemented to prevent unauthorized downloading, copying, extraction, redistribution, or public access.

15. CDN Delivery & Caching

Enterprise customers may use private Content Delivery Networks (CDNs), browser caching, or similar technologies where reasonably necessary to optimize playback performance, provided such technologies do not permit unauthorized public access or downloading of the licensed content.

16. Artwork & Metadata

Where permitted by the applicable license, the Licensee may use associated artwork, cover images, track titles, artist names, album names, and metadata solely for displaying licensed content within approved projects.

17. Catalog Updates

During an active Enterprise License, NCN does not guarantee any minimum number of future releases or updates to the licensed catalog, including newly released tracks, metadata updates, and artwork updates at its discretion.

18. Track Removal / Takedown

NCN reserves the right to remove, replace, or suspend access to individual tracks where required due to copyright claims, licensing changes, legal obligations, or artist requests. Where reasonably possible, NCN will notify affected Enterprise Licensees in advance.

19. Effective Date

Enterprise Licenses become effective upon execution of the applicable Enterprise Agreement and receipt of the agreed license fee unless otherwise agreed in writing.

20. Reporting

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, Enterprise Licensees are not required to submit periodic usage reports.

21. Non-Transferability

All licenses are non-transferable.

Licenses may not be assigned, sublicensed or transferred to another individual, organization or company without prior written permission from NCN.

22. Termination of License

NCN reserves the right to suspend or terminate any license where the Licensee materially breaches these Terms or the applicable license agreement.

Upon termination, the Licensee must cease any future unauthorized use of the licensed content.

Termination does not affect projects lawfully distributed before termination unless required by law or court order.

23. Limitation of Liability

NCN shall not be liable for indirect, incidental, consequential or special damages arising from the use or inability to use the licensed content.

The Licensee assumes full responsibility for ensuring compliance with applicable laws and platform policies.

24. Modifications

NCN reserves the right to update these Licensing Terms at any time.

Changes do not retroactively affect rights already granted under an active license unless required by law or mutually agreed in writing.

25. Force Majeure

NCN shall not be liable for delays or failure to perform its obligations where such delay or failure results from events beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to natural disasters, war, governmental actions, internet outages, cyberattacks, labor disputes, or failures of third-party service providers.

26. Governing Law

These Terms shall be governed by the laws applicable to the Licensor's business jurisdiction unless otherwise specified in a separate Enterprise Agreement.

27. Acceptance of Terms

By purchasing, subscribing to, or otherwise obtaining a license from No Copyright Nasheeds (NCN), the Licensee confirms that they have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Licensing Terms.
